### Airports

**Portland International Jetport (PWM)** is approximately 1½ hours from Bremen, Maine by car. From the Portland airport you may travel by limo or by bus to Damariscotta, where we will pick you up and drop you off, or by limo directly to the boat dock. See details on limo and bus service to make reservations and plan your flights. You may also rent a car in Portland.

**Logan International Airport (BOS)** is approximately 3 hours from Bremen by car. From Logan Airport, **Concord Coach Lines** has one bus a day to and from Damariscotta, Maine with a departure of 11:30 a.m. and arrival of 3:30 p.m.

### Limos to/from Portland Airport

Advance reservations are recommended (as soon as you book your flights). Have your flight information ready when making the reservation. There is no discount for round-trip purchase.

#### Mid-coast Limo

**Prices:** \$75, one-way, \$10 for each additional person arriving on the same flight. Drop off is McDonalds in Damariscotta. We will pick you up between 3 and 4 p.m. on your arrival day and drop you off at approximately 8 a.m. on the day of your departure.

**Prices:** \$75 one way, \$20 for each additional person. Drop off is at the Audubon dock in Bremen.

### Train between Boston and Portland

**Amtrak Downeaster** has 5 trains/day between Boston and Portland, Maine. Travel time is 2½ hours and drop-off in Portland is at the Portland Transportation Center (100 Thompson's Point Road). Transportation to/from the Portland Transportation Center and Portland airport is \$8 taxi (allow 15 min). **Prices** vary based on time of day and peak travel periods. Book in advance for best rates. You may purchase tickets online, over the phone, from stations, from a travel agent or by mail but not onboard.

### Taxi service

**Twin Village Taxi** offers 24/7 transportation throughout Lincoln County and beyond. Fare from hotels in Damariscotta to the camp dock in Bremen is ~\$15. Portland to Damariscotta is \$90. Call (207) 380-0050.

### Bus to/from Damariscotta

**Concord Coach Lines** is the only bus line that services Coastal Route 1 in Maine. If you begin your trip on Greyhound or another bus line, you must switch to Concord Coach Lines in Boston or Portland to catch the bus. In Boston, service begins at either Logan Airport or South Station.

**Prices:** From Boston: \$34 one-way, \$60 round-trip. From Portland: \$17 one-way, \$28 round trip. Tickets must be purchased at the terminal. Online ticket purchasing may become available later in 2011.

**Plan to arrive at least an hour before departure to ensure a seat on the bus.**

**Schedule:** There is one bus to and from Damariscotta each day. To Damariscotta: Depart Boston 11:30 a.m., depart Portland Transportation Center at 2 p.m. Arrival at 3:30 p.m. at Waltz Pharmacy, Main Street. From Damariscotta: Depart Waltz Pharmacy at 9:35 a.m., arrive Portland 11 a.m., arrive Boston 1:25 p.m.. A taxi to/from Portland airport and the Portland transportation center is \$8 taxi (allow 15 min).
