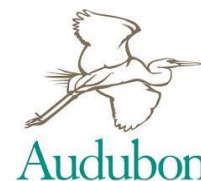

Cancellations & Refund schedule

The program manager will issue a full refund (less \$100 deposit) when a notice of cancellation is received in writing up to 90 days before the start of the program.
