

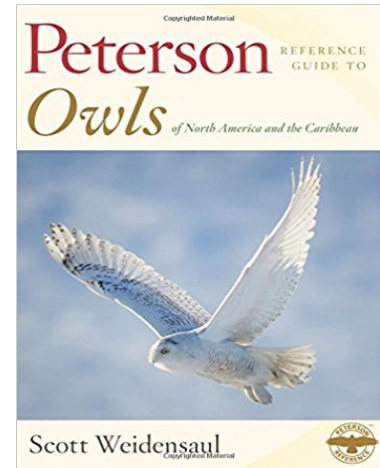

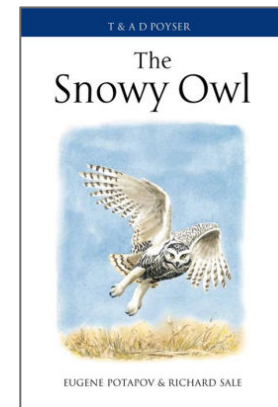
## Books
