Please notify us by email when you have selected a scholarship winner so we can send them a registration form and welcome packet. You must provide name and contact information for recipients by April 1st, 2019.

Cancellations & Refund schedule

The program manager will issue a full refund (less \$100 deposit) when a notice of cancellation is received in writing up to 90 days before the start of the program (email hogisland@audubon.org). Half of a full refund (less \$100 deposit) will be issued for cancellation requests received in writing up to 30 days before the program. No refunds will be offered for cancellations within 29 days of the program start date. We strongly suggest discussion with your participant about their responsibilities to your organization in the event of their cancellation. All reservations can be transferrable to another applicant within the same summer season. All reservations can be transferred to a different session, space provided at no additional fee. Reservations cannot be carried over from one year to the next.
